At any point in time we'll have up to ten real ales available. The selection changes according to the season and what's particularly good right now. The list below reflects the sort of choice you might expect to find.

Black Sheep Bitter 3.8%

A well hopped, light golden best bitter with a distinctive, dry, refreshing taste, to be enjoyed in true Black sheep style through a rich creamy head. Brewed using traditional methods and finest ingredients.

Courage Directors Bitter 4.8%

Directors bitter is a top premium cask ale with a strong following in London and the South East. It is a genuine premium ale, pale brown in appearance with a deep rich taste. As part of the Courage family with over 200 years of brewing pedigree, it was originally brewed for the Directors of the Alton Brewery and not for public sale.

Wells Bombardier 4.1%

A burnished copper colour, Bombadier has a rich, tempting aroma of peppery hops and raisins, while the palate is dominated by more dark fruit, juicy malt and tangy hops.

Spitfire 4.2%

Brewed by Shepherd Neame of Faversham, this golden ale combines an underlying depth of maltiness, tinged with a subtle hint of toffee, with the bold citrus and fruity spiciness of Kentish hops to produce a well balanced, thirst quenching popular drink.

Timothy Taylor Landlord 4.3%

A full drinking pale ale with a complex hoppy aroma.

Abbot Ale 5%

A rich strong ale brewed for longer to give a smooth fuller flavour. Brewed by Greene King.

Greene King IPA 3.6%

A clean, fresh, hoppy taste and distinctive tawny colour. Brewed in Bury St Edmunds using a unique variety of yeasts. The flavour and aroma of Suffolks favourite ale is the result of using English Challenger and First Gold Hops combined with pale and crystal malts.

Ruddles County 4.7%

English ale with a distinctive flavour of dark toffee and caramel, combined with a crisp bitterness derived from using Bramling Cross Hops.

Swan with Two Nicks 4.2%

A stronger than average session beer with a mellow hoppy nose and smooth aftertaste. A full toffee like malty palate and exceptional appearance in the glass.
